
How do I access the Learning Place from home?

Solution


To access The Learning Place from home:

1. Open a compatible web browser (e.g. Internet Explorer/Edge, Safari, Google Chrome or Firefox.)

Type 'learningplace.eq.edu.au' in the address bar and press enter.




2. This will take you to The Learning Place website as shown below:



3. Scroll down the page to until you see the 'Access the Learning Place' box on the left hand side of the page.

Click on the 'eLearn (Blackboard)' link.

What's happening

Learning Continuity Planning Supporting teachers and students to connect and continue learning during school closures or disruptions. Learning continuity planning has information you need for moving your classroom online and working with school colleagues.




